Higher Education Forum Names Filipino Amerasian Diaspora Research Scholar to HEF Consultancy and Advisory Board in Taipei, Taiwan- Republic of China

TAIPEI, Taiwan-Republic of China – Dr. P.C. “Pete” Kutschera, Ph.D., Executive Director of the Filipino Amerasian research NPO, the Amerasian Research Network, LTD, USA, the Philippine Amerasian Research Center, Angeles, and Visiting Professor and Research Fellow at Don Honorio Ventura Technological State University, Pampanga, Luzon, Philippines, has been appointed to the Core Committee Board of consultants and academic advisors of the Higher Education Forum (<http://www.prohef.org>) in Taipei, Taiwan. HEF’s Core Committee Board is comprised of a panel of published research fellows, professors, post-doctoral and senior academics from throughout East and Southeast Asia. The committee’s mission is to provide connectivity, consultant, advisory and liaison assistance to the global academic community which comprises HEF’s professional customer and service base.

Dr. Kutschera has been associated with HEF since September, 2013 HEF when he presented a social work paper (See: URL Link: <http://amerasianresearch.org/pdf/YYCertICEASS2013ParadigmPaper.pdf>) served as chair of a paper presentation panel and conference advisory board member at the International Conference on Education and Social Sciences (ICEASS-2013) in Singapore. His appointment to the HEF advisory panel was confirmed by HEF senior executive managers Kate Lee and Judy Chou in Taipei in late September. “It’s an honor for the Amerasian research movement to receive this kind of recognition.
